









SJCC Goes Global 3 International Awards for Balloons



SJCC at a Glance

St Joseph College of Communication (SJCC) affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, is the result of the creative response of the Archdiocese of Changanassery to the moral bankruptcy in the field of media. When Archbishop Joseph Powathil's vision and leadership combined with the commitment and efficiency of Rev. Fr. Sebastian Punnassery and the stewardship of Rev. Fr. Joseph Kochukarottu, the first university affiliated media college in South India was born in 2004. The academic excellence and experience of Prof. John Sankaramangalam, the first principal of SJCC, took it to the heights of glory in a short span of time. Thus in an era in which institutions offering courses in visual media were very few in India and none in Kerala, SJCC took the "road less travelled" and opened the doors of visual media to the aspiring youngsters of Kerala.

SJCC completes its 20 years of dedicated service to the society "transforming the media for a wholesome world". The college is first of its kind in South India hosting more than 1000 students in 7 undergraduate and 4 postgraduate courses. Hence the resource pool at SJCC and the exchange of ideas taking place is unparalleled.

SJCC, working with the motto "Values in Visuals", equips students not only with moral values and right attitude towards life and society but also with the requisite skills as per the requirements of the industry. With this aim we have established 90.8 Radio Media Village, MVTV,

State of the art Recording and Mixing Studio, and Animation Studio which give ample opportunities for students to work in a professional environment and gain job experience while studying in the campus. The college also provides hostel facilities for boys.

We were also fortunate to host several dignitaries like Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam, the former president of India in 2008, Shri Vayalar Ravi, the union minister for Overseas Indian Affairs in 2012 and Shri Ommen Chandy, the then Chief Minister of Kerala in 2004, Renowned cine artists like Padmasri Madhu, Director Priyadarsan, Sound Designer Resul Pookutty, Director of FTII Dharmendra Jain Narian, Vocalist K. S. Chithra, Sculptor Kanayi Kunhiraman and other renowned artists have also graced the campus with their esteemed presence on various occasions. Moreover, eminent lecturers from FTII Pune visit the campus on a regular basis and take sessions for the students on various film related topics.

The values and vibes of this institution have spread far and wide through the alumni working in various media organizations, design studios and in the film industry from Hollywood to Bollywood to Mollywood. The alumni of SJCC have become inevitable members of the faculty in various media colleges in the state. Multitude of innovative and creative initiatives taken by the college during the last decade of its service has made it the trailblazer in the arena of media studies

Milestones

- 2004 St Joseph College of Communication, affiliated to MG University Kottayam was established in the month of August. Two professional degree courses, BA Animation and Graphic Design and BA Multimedia, were started at the college. Prof. John Sankaramangalam former Director FTII, Pune was appointed as the first Principal.
- 2005 St Joseph College of Communication was formally inaugurated by Sri. Oommen Chandy, Hon. Chief Minister of Kerala on July 2. Affiliation was granted to the first PG course at the college, MA Cinema and Television.
- 2006 St Joseph College of Communication hosted SJCC International Film Festival at Changanacherry. Placement Cell was opened and Media Companies began to visit the campus for recruitment. International educational cooperation projects were launched.
- 2007 Mar Joseph Perumthottam became the Patron of the College. Scholarship for meritorious students

- was established, SJCC Cheriathundam Scholarship.
- 2008 New office and reception was opened and blessed. Media Village "the Great Media Project" was launched by Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam, former President of India.
- 2009 Audio Video studios were updated. Career orientation programmes were started at the College.
- 2010 The new hostel for boys in the campus was opened. Affiliation was granted to MA Animation, MA Multimedia and MA Graphic Design.
- 2011 Prof. John Sankaramangalam was relieved from the responsibility of principal and was reappointed as the Academic Chairman of the College. Rev. Dr. Wilson Kottam was appointed Principal.
- 2012 A Community FM CR Station named 90.8 Radio Media Village was started by the college under the license of Government of India. International firms

- like RR Donnelly visited the campus for recruitment. Inter-collegiate media fest 'Melange' was started.
- 2013 Rev. Dr. Wilson Kottam was relieved from the office of principal and Prof.Chandramohan Nair was appointed Principal. Affiliation was granted to the UG course BA Visual Arts and the PG course MA Print and Electronic Journalism. Advanced Audio Video Studio, Digital Library, 2D Lab, 3D Lab and Mini Theatre were established. 90.8 Radio Media Village received the highest National honour from the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting for the community engagement projects and programmes.
- 2014 The tenth anniversary of the college was celebrated with the mega event named "Media Sagra" on 13, 14 & 15 January. The presence of celebrities like Sri. Rasool Pookutty, Sri. Kanayi Kunhiraman, Sri. Priyadarsan, Sri Dharmendra Jain Narian (Director FTII Pune) added grandeur to the occasion. Radio Media Village was honoured by Govt. of India for the second consecutive year with the National Award for

sustainability.

- 2015 Affiliation was granted to the UG Courses BA Visual Communication. BA Animation & Visual Effects. BA Audiography & Digital Editing. Radio Media Village has won the National Award (Thematic Category) from the ministry of Information and Broadcasting for the third consecutive year.
- 2016 Prof.Chandramohan Nair was relieved from the office of the Principal and was reappointed as the academic director of the College. Rev. Dr. Joseph Parackal was appointed Principal. Two new projects are launched, MVTV & MV Studios to impart student in practical learning.
- 2017 Renowned playback singer Mrs. K. S Chithra inaugurated the newly built Surround Mixing Studio (Atmos Premix) on 24 October 2017.
- 2018 Bangalore chapter of the alumni association was inaugurated on 8 April 2018. The first Principal and the serving Academic Chairman of SJCC, Prof. John Sankaramangalam expired

- on 30 July 2018. 90.8 Radio Media Village won the second prize in the most creative/innovative category from the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting. Government of India.
- 2019 The first edition of the John Sankaramangalam Lecture series was held on 11 February 2019. Renowned film director Shri. Adoor Gopalakrishnan delivered the lecture on "Cinema as an Art Form". The Cochin Chapter of the Alumni Association was inaugurated on 4 May 2019. Affiliation was granted for B. Com Finance & Taxation. New Foley Recording Studio for Media Village Communications was inaugurated. The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India honoured 90.8 Radio Media Village with the second prize in Sustainability Category and third prize in Promoting Local Culture category. MVTV got two Pepper Awards. The Signature film created for Changanassery Fest won the Gold while Oru Chakka Kadha bagged bronze in the webfilm category.
- 2020 As part of eco-friendly initiatives of the college, a hundred kilowatt solar power project was inaugurated by Mr. M. M. Mani honourable electricity minister of Kerala.

- 2021 Affiliation and NOC granted for B.Com Finance & Cooperation
- 2022 SJCC in its attempt to go beyond borders launched a new venture viz., MFTI (Media Village Film & Television Institute). It offers online and offline diploma courses in the field of media.
- 2023 To enhance the learning experience of the students a full-fledged 7.1 theatre named MV Cinemas was blessed and inaugurated. To mark the beginning of the 20th anniversary of the college SJCC Film Festival was begun.
- The Twentieth Anniversary of SJCC marked the launch of new four-year undergraduate programmes in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. As part of a comprehensive syllabus redesign, undergraduate programmes previously known as BA Visual Arts and BA Audiography & Digital Editing were renamed to BA Interior Architecture & Artistry and BA Sound Design & Visual Editing, respectively.

Crown of the Church

Crown of the Church is a biopic of the legendary ecclesial leader of the Syro-Malabar church, Archbishop Mar Joseph Powathil, the visionary founder of SJCC. The movie focuses on the various phases of the life of Mar Joseph Powathil giving special attention to his childhood, school education, seminary life, studies at the Oxford University, life as a Priest, as the Auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Changanassery, as the Bishop of Kanjirappally diocese, as the Arch Bishop of Changanassery, as the Chairman of KCBC and the as the President of CBCI. His social, cultural and religious views and his ideology about the Catholic Church are very well reflected throughout the movie. The guidance given by Mar Joseph Powathil through the media and through his writings regarding the protection of the rights of the dalit Christians received applause from the viewers. The portrayal of his life as the lecturer and the hostel warden at St. Berchmans College, Changanassery adds more colour to the movie. The movie scripted by the famous writer John Paul is directed by Raju Abraham and the cinematography was done by Sajan Kalathil. Media Village Studios at St. Joseph College of Communication, a venture of the Archdiocese of Changanassery, is the producer of the movie.

Archbishop Joseph Powathil: The Visionary Founder of SJCC

His Grace Mar Joseph Powathil, the former Archbishop of Changanassery, had the foresight to recognize the increasing importance of media in 2000. As a patron of respected educational institutions like S B College and Assumption College, Changanassery, he saw the necessity of instilling values in media professionals. Consequently, he conceived the idea of establishing a media college and delegated the responsibility to his diocesan priest, Fr. Sebastian Punnassery. This initiative led to the establishment of St. Joseph College of Communication in 2004, with the vision of transforming media for a wholesome world.

Beyond his role as an educator, Archbishop Joseph Powathil was also a theologian deeply committed to preserving the identity, traditions, and liturgy of the Syro Malabar Church. He fostered strong relationships with various Catholic rites, other Christian denominations, and individuals from different religious backgrounds. He showed particular concern for the disadvantaged, including the poor, orphans, and youth. Archbishop Powathil held SJCC dear to his heart until his passing on March 18, 2023. The college continues to honour his memory with gratitude for his visionary leadership and enduring legacy.




Sankaramangalam Lectures

Prof. John Sankaramangalam was a genius with no parallels in Indian Cinema. His passion towards cinema took him to Film and Television institute of India Pune, where he passed the courses in Scripting and Direction with the first rank. Along with making his own contributions in the film industry, he spent his time and energy in moulding the budding talents in the field. He later became the director of FTII and continued his efforts to bring up a generation of artists with creativity and conviction.

Even after his retirement from FTII he still continued his service to the field of film making by taking up the stewardship of St Joseph College of Communication, Changanassery, first of its kind in South India in 2004. It was Prof. John Sankaramangalam's leadership with clear vision and determination made it the premium destination for media studies in South India. Even after retiring from the post of Principal in 2011 he continued to serve the college in the capacity of Academic Chairman till his death on 30 July 2018. In honour of its founding principal SJCC conducts a lecture series in his name once in every two years. The first edition of the John Sankaramangalam Lectures series was held on 11 February 2019. Renowned film director Shri. Adoor Gopalakrishnan delivered the lecture on "Cinema as an Art Form".
